Sigma chapter invited Mary Lee Turner, from the Oregon Commission for the Blind, to give a presentation on teaching of older blind people on how to live with their disability. I would make the recommendation that every club consider a similar program as we all face the possibility of vision loss from a number of causes and many teachers must deal with vision loss students in their classrooms.
